Fiberglass Maintenance Instructions

Normal Cleaning

Never use abrasive cleaners such as scouring powders or pads, steel wool, scrapers, sandpaper, or anything that could scratch or dull the surface of your unit. Instead use warm water and liquid detergents recommended for cleaning fiberglass.

It is recommended that you wax your fiberglass unit with simple car wax one or two times per year.

Hard Water

Water in certain regions may cause fading of some colors. This is a natural occurrence beyond our control.

To Restore a Scratched or Dull Unit

Use an automotive polishing compound applied with a clean cotton rag. Follow with a light coat of liquid wax. Buff to a shine.

Deep scratches require professional restoration.

When using any cleaning or polishing materials, make sure to read and follow all package instructions carefully. Wear rubber gloves at all times and avoid contact with eyes, skin, clothing, rugs, and furnishings. Make sure all residues are rinsed off thoroughly.

Use caution when cleaning your fiberglass unit. Not all products have been tested on all units and materials. Certain product labels have "safe for fiberglass" listed, however there are certain units on which even a "safe for fiberglass" product can "bleach" the color.
